22 The application of plaintiffs for the preliminary injunction came on regularly for hearing
23 by the court this date in accordance with an order to show cause issued by this court
24 on September 5, 2019. Plaintiffs appeared by counsel Chitra Ramanathan, Esq.; defendants
25 appeared by counsel Jagdeep Hansra, Esq.

26 On proof made to the court's satisfaction, and good cause appearing:

27 **IT IS ORDERED** that during the pendency of this action the above-named defendants, and
28 each of them, and their officers, agents, board members, employees, representatives, and all
persons acting in concert or participating with them, are enjoined and restrained from engaging

1 in, committing, or performing, directly or indirectly, by any means whatsoever, any of the
2 following acts:


3 Holding an election for the Parbandhak Committee (board of directors), approval of
4 construction-related expenditures exceeding \$250,000, or amendment of the bylaws of
5 the defendant Gurdwara, presently noticed and set for September 22, 2019.

7 The court reserves jurisdiction to modify this preliminary injunction as the ends of justice may
8 require. This preliminary injunction shall remain in effect pending further order of the court,
9 including but not limited to a final determination of the merits of the above-captioned complaint.
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11 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, before this order shall take effect, plaintiffs, no later than
12 twelve noon, September 20, 2019, file with the court an undertaking, pursuant to Code of Civil
13 Procedure §529, in the amount of \$60,000.

14 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the parties shall appear for a status conference on September
15 20, 2019, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 12. The parties are free to take the status conference off
16 calendar by stipulation in the event that both are satisfied that the required undertaking has been
17 posted.
